All students are responsible for providing their own transportation to both days of the District competition.

Registration Day-
Thursday 3/2/17- 3:30 to 6:00 ONLY

- **All documentaries, exhibits, performances** must check in at the Lively Technical Center building 14 for pre-judging. (except Historical Papers & websites those are judged early).
- **Entries that fail to present at least a process paper at registration will be disqualified.**
- Groups may have one person at registration instead of all members. Because these are student created projects, **NO PARENTS ARE ALLOWED inside the building.**
- prejudging will look at your title page, process paper, and Annotated List of Works Consulted (bibliography) for errors and exhibits (if applicable), students have a change to fix some mistakes and bring it back Friday morning (8-8:30) with corrections
- Documentaries may test their equipment in the documentary rooms
- Performances may drop off props, but the School Board and Lively are not responsible for any equipment left over night.

No entry will be permitted to register on Friday morning.

Fair Day-
Friday 3/3/17 (Documentaries, Performances, Exhibits)

8:00- 8:20 Check-in with school sponsor
8:00- 8:30 If entries made corrections, return to the building 14, if you don't have corrections, go to cafeteria (building 3)

8:25 Student assembly (rules & other info)
8:45 - noon

- Over an intercom in the cafeteria, students will be called for judging
- Students walk to building 14 and check in
- entries are judged by 2-3 different judges
- students may not be released from Lively until the judges have interviewed them
- No student may leave prior to 12:30 pm. After that time, students must check out with their teacher(s) prior to leaving Lively.

6:00 to 6:45 pm Public Viewing- building 14
6:45 to 7:30 pm Awards Ceremony- building 14 (for all project types)
7:30pm Meeting with those groups attending state

Pre-Judging:
 At registration all process papers, Annotated List of Works Consulted, and exhibits will be pre-judged. Students will be notified of any rules violations which they may correct before 8 a.m.
Three copies of a process paper and Works Consulted are required. This must be typed, with a title page that includes only The TITLE, Division, Category, and your name(s) and word count. See NHD.com for details
 Papers are stapled one time in the upper left-hand corner

Discipline:
 Any student who violates the district Student Code of Conduct will be disqualified and reported to school officials
 Attendance will be taken.
 Students who do not attend the fair or leave early will be reported to school officials

Dress Code:
 On Friday, dress in the traditional business or church attire for your interview with the judges.
 Performers will wear costumes during the competition, therefore be sure to wear something that makes changing easy.
